## Recycling Tips for the Holidays in the Vail Valley

### - Break down cardboard boxes

(when boxes are not flattened the trash truck has to pick them up and the customer may be charged extra)

### - Plastic film and bubble wrap can NOT go in the curbside recycle bin

(it can be recycled with plastic bags, check your local grocer or Walmart to see if they will take all soft plastics)

### - Take all decorations off of trees

(trees can be disposed of for burning or recycling at designated drop sites, see our tree guide for more details)

### - Christmas lights can NOT go in the curbside recycle bin

(they can be placed in the trash or taken to a certified recycler like the Eagle County HHW)

### - Ornaments & decorations can NOT go in the curbside recycle bin

(this includes plastic & glass ornaments, tinsel and beads)

### - Consider donating old toys & clothes instead of trowing them in the trash

(resale shops like Vail Valley Cares Thrifty Shop and Eagle Valley Community Fund can take old toys and clothes)

### - Do NOT place electronics in the curbside recycle bin or the trash

(it is against the law to improperly dispose of electronics, they must be taken to a certified recycler or Eagle County HHW)

### - Light bulbs and batteries can NOT go in the curbside recycle bin

(they can be placed in the trash or taken to a certified recycler, the Eagle County HHW, or your local hardware store)
